Because the neighborhood transportation study so vitally affects our neighborhood, WPNA is scheduling our next three meetings to coincide with the Neighborhood Traffic Study meetings to be held at Winnona Park School. The WPNA meetings will begin at 6:45 p.m. and the traffic study meetings at 7:30 The dates are Wednesday, May 2, p.m. May 23, and June 20. All meetings will be in the school auditorium. The first meeting, May 2, is for us to tell them what we see as our traffic problems. At the second meeting, May 23, they will offer suggestions to us on how to solve the problems and get our opinion on their proposals. At the third meeting, June 20, they will show us the proposals they will present to the City Commission.


